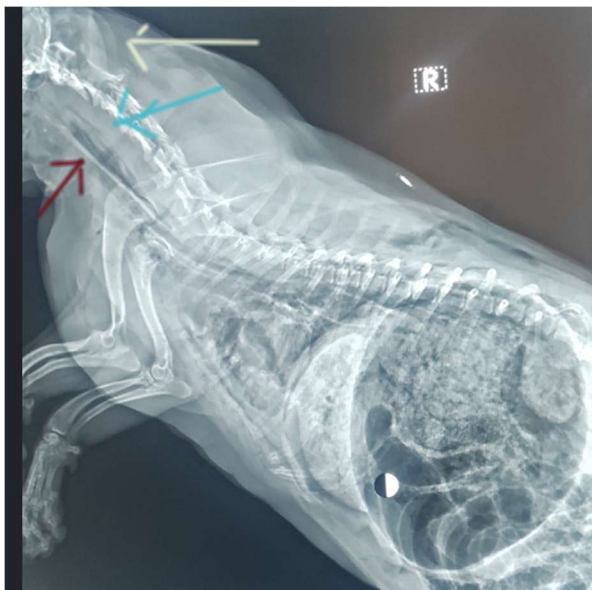
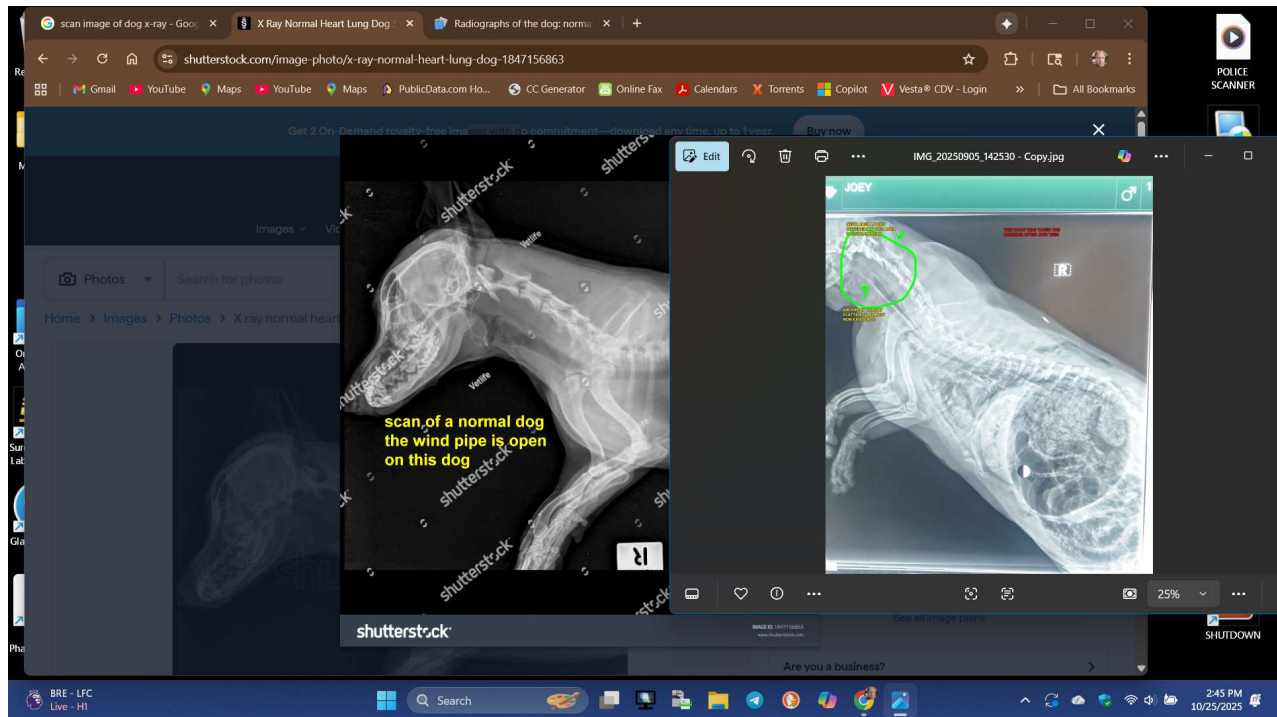


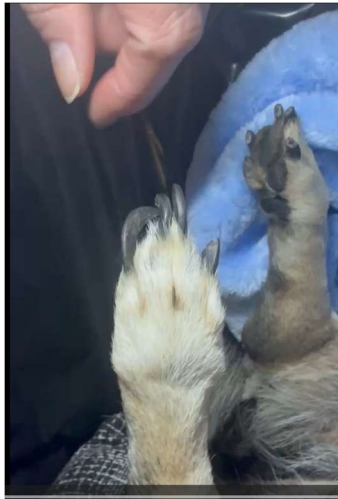
Photos of Joey' x-ray and a normal dog x-ray



Joeys x-ray
Clearly shows the windpipe does not extend up to the mouth area. It shows the windpipe has been crushed around the neck region.

Also shows the neck area is abnormal most likely from a fracture

Photos of Joey's nail trim



This shows Joeys nails before cutting and that anyone cutting a dogs nails would know the quick has outgrown here and that cutting the nails so short would cause pain and bleeding.



Nails cut way too short. This is NOT a standard short cut.

Notice the Quick Stop on each nail and the outgrown quick on each nail

This cut caused Joey extreme pain.



Joeys nails cut way too short here. This is NOT standard short or 'SHOW' trim.



Joeys nails cut too short here.

Notice the Quick Stop on each nail.

This caused Joey severe pain and bleeding.



Joeys nails too short.

Each nail shows the quick was exposed and cut on each nail and Quick Stop added to stop the bleeding.

Imagine your fingers being cut at the first knuckle from your fingernail. That's what Joey felt during this nail trim.

This is NOT a standard nail trim, this was pure very painful torture on every cut Club Hill Animal Clinic put Joey through.
